# Term 3 in Review: Community Voice, Uniform Updates, Academic Academy 2026

#### School Review

In Week 9, a School Review was conducted and 272 staff, students, parents and community members. The review provided a number of affirmations celebrating the work of the school over the past four years and across the 2022-2025 Strategic Plan.

The review also provided a series of suggested next steps or Improvement Strategies that we will ensure are incorporated in the next Strategic Plan for 2026-2029.

A parent consultation process will occur over Term 4 to assist with the development of this plan and the strategic direction of the school. Please keep an eye out for the EOI in the coming months.

#### Formal Uniform
