Instrument Purchase or Hire

- The school has some instruments that will be available for use by beginning students. Instruments can be hired for the duration of the year for \$25. This amount contributes to the cost of repairing and servicing the instruments. School instruments will be distributed as fairly as possible. While every effort is given to provide your student with their first choice of instrument, this is not always possible.
- Alternatively, you may wish to purchase an instrument for your child. Students with their own instruments are only required to pay the \$30 levy.
