A non-refundable levy of \$30.00 will apply for participation in the school's Instrumental Music Program, regardless how many instruments a student is learning. There is an additional non-refundable \$20 hire fee **per school instrument hired**.

Invoices will be issued during Term One. Please do not pay the levy until you have received your invoice.

Please note that the levy must be paid before the end of Term One. If payment is not received by this time, your student will no longer be able to participate in the program and/or use the school's instrument. If you are experiencing difficulties meeting this financial commitment, please contact the Business Service Manager to arrange a payment plan.

Students borrowing a school instrument will be issued with the instrument when full payment and a completed Loan Agreement Form have been submitted.

Once at an appropriate level, students are expected to participate in a school ensemble. The String Ensemble (for violin, viola, cello and double bass) rehearses one lunch break per week. The Concert Band (for woodwind, brass, percussion and bass guitar) rehearses once per week from 3.10pm – 4.00pm.
