OBJECTIVES :

- · actively participates and lead Arts extra-curricular events
- · demonstrates their acceptance of other students around them
- organises and runs an Arts-orientated activity that promotes the Arts ethos
- shows willingness to promote the Arts within the school and wider community
- maintains positive professional relationships with staff and peers in the Arts
- takes leadership opportunities to coach and mentor peers in the Arts
- submits completed assessment tasks, adhering to all due dates in all subjects
- · demonstrates a balance over their workload within all subject areas
- punctual arrival at class
- media clearance
- consideration of others through general behaviour that is of an excellent standard (seen as proactive in the promotion of the school and its code of expectations and actively modelling of appropriate behaviour for other students)
- Arts Night and Awards Night representative, including the presentation of awards
- represents the Arts in newspaper and promotions
- coordinates and collects footage of the Arts
- inspires and encourages links between the school, the community and The Arts and IT by accessing industry professionals and through performance and projects
- provides insight into how an education in The Arts
