BYOD – Bring your own device (laptop or iPad)

It is a mandatory requirement for all **STEM Academy students** to bring their own device. Non-STEM students are also welcome to join the program at any point during their junior schooling.

Next steps to joining the program, students and parents/carers must:

- read and understand BYOD requirements
- check minimum specifications required for your device
- complete and sign a BYOD Agreement form and return to the IT department, along with the device so it can be set up on the network.

Student ID Cards are provided to all students, these cards can be used to ensure student discounts are given (e.g. public transport etc.). They also have the student's MIS ID code, which is needed to access the school computers, printing and other school resources. **Replacement card cost is \$5.00.**

Student printing credit at the beginning of each school year every student is provided with \$10 printing credit. This is used through the students ID Card. Should the student use all the printing credit they can purchase a top up with the cashier or through the QKr App.

Student planners each student is provided with a planner (diary), planners are a school requirement and it is expected students will have a planner every day at school. **Replacement cost for a junior planner is \$11.00.**
