# **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

The Uniform Shop is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:00am – 12:00noon, in school terms. It will open every day only in the week before school begins.

The school community and the Parents' and Citizens' Association (P&C) endorses the wearing of a school uniform. They believe that the correct wearing of our school uniform not only encourages mutual respect between students but that it also helps to provide a safe and supportive environment.

Beaudesert State High School has a school uniform policy that must be enacted during school hours. Students are not permitted to mix 'Formal Uniform' and 'Sports Uniform' items.

#### **Students Out of Uniform**

- Must go and speak with the year level HOD at Student Services and provide a note before 8:50am.
- Students are expected to access alternative clothing provided by the school and available at Student Services.

## **Winter Uniform Requirements**




In winter, students may also choose to wear the following optional items:

- Beanies (navy only)
- Gloves (navy only)
- Scarves (navy only)
- Stockings may be worn with the 'Formal' uniform (black or natural colours)

**Hats:** Students are required to wear a hat during Health and Physical Education, Agriculture lessons and outdoor sport. This is a sun safety requirement.

### **Footwear Requirements**

- Students are required to wear shoes that are either all black or all white.
- Students are not permitted to wear shoes with different colours or designs (e.g. all black shoes with white details).
- Students must ensure they wear white socks that are visible (e.g. above their ankle).



## **Hair Requirements**

- Hairstyles neat, clean and tidy.
- Hair Colour must be 'natural' tones.

Students must ensure that hair longer than their collar is tied-up when accessing practical subject environments (e.g. workshops, kitchens).

#### **Additional Considerations:**

#### **Jewellery**

Beaudesert State High School Staff reserves the right to determine which jewellery is acceptable:

- Facial Piercings one 'flat' nose stud.
- Earrings one set of either 'sleeper' or 'stud' earrings.
- Necklaces must not be visible.
- Bracelets must not be worn.
- Rings two maximum.

#### Makeup

Beaudesert State High School Staff reserves the right to direct students to remove makeup or nail polish.

- Makeup 'natural' looking only.
- Nail Polish must not be worn.

# PERSONAL PROPERTY & VALUABLES

Valuables should be left at home to prevent loss or theft. Students need to take all reasonable precautions to prevent loss of, or damage to, personal property whilst at school.

We advise students to:

- Ensure they do not leave money or valuables in their school bags.
- Not bring items of value or sentiment to school.
- Always keep their school bags as close as possible to them.

All clothing, books and other articles should be clearly marked with the student's name to reduce the chance of theft and for ease of identification.

If items are lost, students should report this to the year level HOD of Student Services immediately. Efforts will be made to recover the missing item; however, the school cannot accept responsibility for goods stolen or lost and no insurance policy exists to cover the cost of lost or stolen items belonging to students.
