- ✓ No longer attending school
- ✓ Be a Queensland resident
- ✓ Be an Australian or New Zealand permanent resident (some visas apply)
- ✓ Students must be able to obtain:
 - Working with Children Check (Blue Card)
 - NDIS Workers Screening Card (Yellow Card)
 - National Police Check



VOCATIONAL PLACEMENT

Participants must complete **120 hours** of vocational placement.

Placement must take place between: 6.00am – 6.00pm Monday to Friday.
