Under this agreement for 2022 Beaudesert State High School will receive

\$754,104

This funding will be used to

Allow the creation of a student services hub containing 3 Student Services HODs, a youth support worker (A04) and an extra day's salary of a Speech Therapist

Audio Visual equipment for MPH and classrooms to allow more effective communication of PBL strategies and wellbeing strategies to students.

Overall funds will be targeting the creation of a more supportive environment for students, staff and community members.

- Targeted measures of improvement in line with strategic plan and AIP: 2.5% improvement in common SOS (school opinion survey) elements (student, staff and parent categories), 2.5% reduction in major referrals, SDA's (school disciplinary absences) and exclusions.
- 6 monthly review conducted in line with data plan and data scorecard review of all targets from AIP and strategic plan aligned to 9 SIU Domains.

Our initiatives include

Instruction: Student services HODs line manage Get Connected teachers through a holistic academic coaching cycle focussed on study skills and social emotional development activities via the PBL framework.

Youth support worker case manages at risk students and runs targeted intervention programs for improved Year 7-9 student engagement. Staff trained in mental health first aid to improve pedagogical strategies via implementation of trauma informed practices.

Speech Therapist co-ordinates literacy intervention program Multi Lit and co-teaches in our FLI intervention classes to ensure teachers are using expert teaching strategies for our below NMS Reading and Writing students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchase of 3 x HOD positions (Student services) – \$535,000
- Purchase of Student Well-being officer A04 - \$95,000
- Installation of Audio visual equipment in MPH and classrooms without access to online meetings/parades - \$65,000
- Purchase of an extra day for speech therapist in intervention classes \$12,000
- Miscellaneous salaries from last year's program still being paid in January and February \$40,000
