If you are currently receiving Centrelink payments you can arrange to have payments deducted automatically from your Centrelink allowance. You can pay from \$15 per fortnight per student and the money is direct credited to the school account. There is no charge to you for this service. ## **Student Resource Scheme**

This scheme is authorised to operate under the education (general provision)act 2006 and Department of Education, Training and Employment policy.

The scheme's major purpose is to provide an extremely cost effective and efficient strategy to parents and students which:

- Eliminates shopping for text books, novels and resources

It is timely to reflect that the government supplies the tuition fees and basic general foundations for the delivery of student curriculum programs. Please note – the student resource scheme fees have had the cost of the government textbook allowance deducted to reduce the total cost which parents are required to pay. However, as has always been the case, the cost of books, stationary and additional resources has been the responsibility of parents and students.

All monies raised through this scheme are expended directly on the students of the school on an annual basis.
