


How to Download Office 365 to a 32-bit Computer

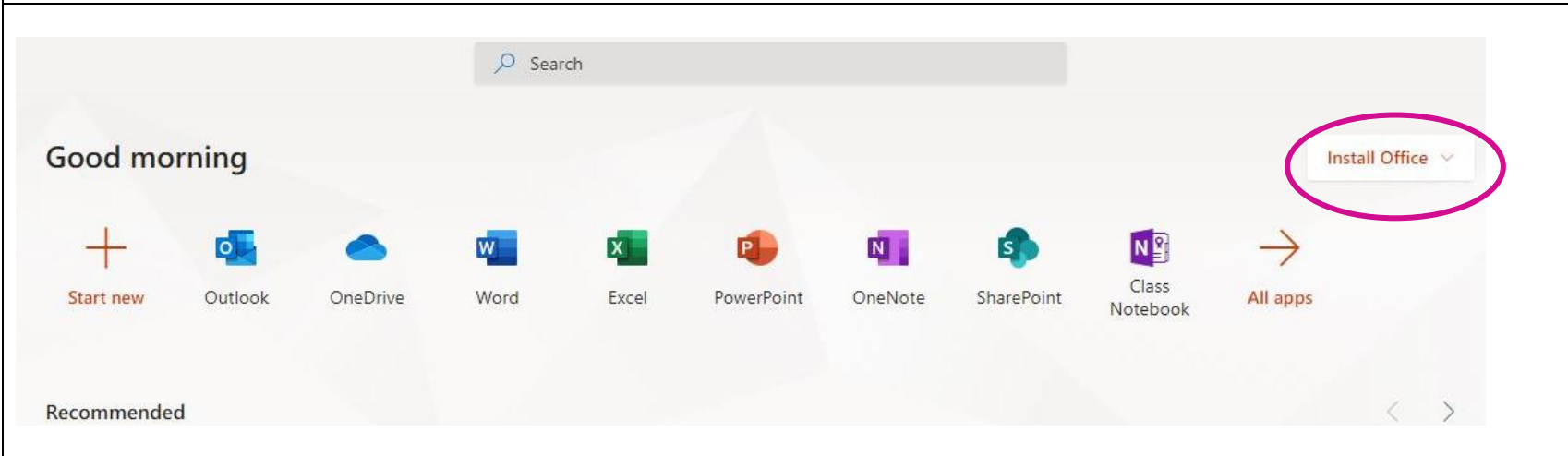
All students are able to access their Education Queensland email account outside school. To do this, open your browser and search for "owa.eq.edu.au"

You will need to enter your school logon and password.

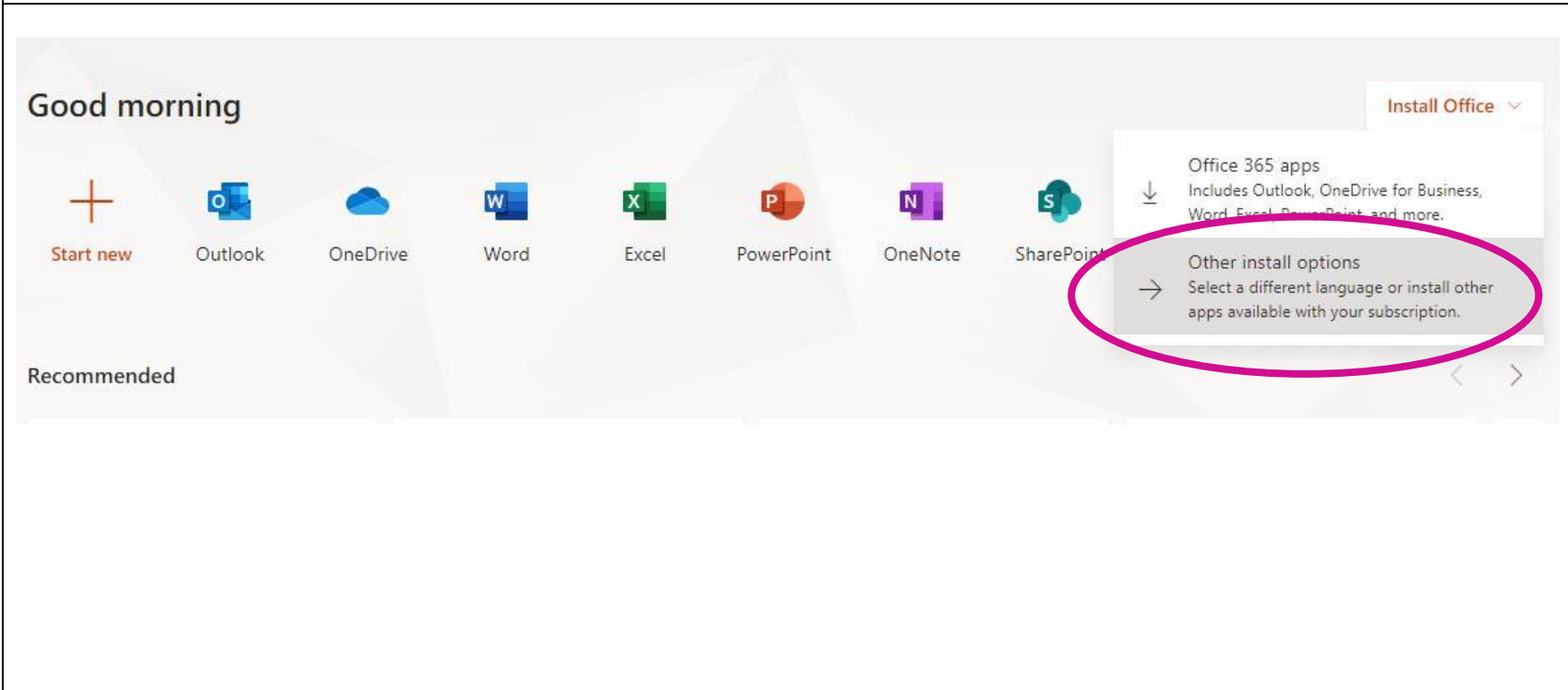
When your school emails open, click on the square with 9 dots in the top left of your screen.

Click on the link to Office 365.


